

OUR PROPOSAL FOR ARTEFACT WEEK SPRINGBOARDS OFF THE PREVIOUS TOPIC OF FOCUS FOR THE DERIVA AND INTERVENTION: BRINGING A NEW AWARENESS AND CONNECTION TO WATER TO CARTAGENA'S INHABITANTS WHERE THERE PREVIOUSLY WAS NONE.

ALLOTTED A SITE THAT RUNS THROUGH THE BUSY PUBLIC SQUARES OF PLAZA DE LOS COCHES AND PLAZA DE LA PAZ, THE OBJECTIVE OF OUR URBAN SCHEME BECAME TO IMPLEMENT A PHYSICAL AND SYMBOLIC PRESENCE OF WATER AT THE SITE. WE DID THIS THROUGH A SERIES OF CONSIERED VOIDS.

OUR PROCESS INVOLVED EXAMINING TRANSFORMATIONS THAT HISTORY HAD BROUGHT TO THIS SITE (PREVIOUSLY THE STRAIT BETWEEN TWO ISLANDS). THE RESULTING SCHEME INVOLVES STRIPS OF FUNCTIONAL, ACTIVATED PUBLIC SPACE.
